**Position Summary:**

Children in our Head Start program are in need of coats & boots for winter. Community Action Partnership of Ramsey & Washington Counties serves nearly 1,500 Head Start children yearly. In these early education programs, our team of educators, family advocates and volunteers help low-income youth from ages 3-5 prepare for success when they enter kindergarten. Our Early Head Start program assists families with younger children and pregnant women.

**Essential Functions:**

**Duties & Responsibilities:**

- An individual or group of volunteers will host a collection drive and/or purchase coats and/or boots
- For each collection/assembly effort a minimum of five coats or boot-sets are requested, more are welcome
- Submit a timesheet to the Volunteer Specialist
- If a group, the leader must keep track of the number of volunteers assisting and total hours donated

**Item Requirements:**

- Infant or toddler outerwear (newborn to age 3) one-piece and two-piece accepted
- Preschooler outerwear (children age 3 - 5) one-piece and two-piece accepted
- Boots for infant to child age 5 are accepted
- New or gently used
- Items must be clean when delivered
- Hats, mittens, scarves and/or blankets (optional)
- Home-made/hand-crafted knitted, crocheted or sewn items are acceptable

**Time Commitment:**

- Time depends upon how many items that you wish to collect or create
- This volunteer opportunity must be conducted entirely at your location and delivered to our St Paul office
- Register *before* you begin collecting items and contact us *before* you drop them off
- If possible, deliver items by November. However, items are accepted throughout the winter
